Established in 1968 by citizens and school boards of the North Shore, Howe Sound and the Sunshine Coast, Capilano College has served the evolving post-secondary needs of the region. In 2008 it became Capilano University. In May 2013 a \$1.3 million dollar budget shortfall led to a dramatic cut of over \$3 million dollars in academic programs in commerce, computer science, adult basic education, art & design, applied business and others. The education ministry has indicated there is enough money to deliver programming, but an anticipated budget shortfall for 2014 is suggesting even more cuts in academic programming are coming. The broader community has been absent from these discussions and decisions until now!
