F. CFA Meeting Block

Faculty member Susan Gardner has asked that the following motions be considered for discussion today, with the possibility of a vote at the next meeting.

Background:

Article 3.3.3 of the 2007-2010 CFA Collective Agreement reads as follows:

Instructional activities and duties shall be scheduled in a manner which ensures Tuesdays from Noon to 1:00 p.m. or from 12:30-1:30 p.m. being free to allow employees to attend Union meetings. The Union shall be advised by the College of instructional activities schedule by March 1 of each year.

1. Motion 1

I move that this article be interpreted (1) so as not to preclude faculty members from holding office hours and/or meetings with students on the alternate Tuesdays to those scheduled for CFA meetings, and (2) so as not to preclude faculty from meeting with one another on the alternate Tuesdays to those scheduled for CFA meetings (as long as such meetings do not interfere with other faculty obligations).

2. Motion 2

Since article 3.3.3 is interpreted by the union as requiring faculty to refrain from holding office hours, meeting with students, or meeting with each other, lunch hours on Tuesdays (or during CFA meetings on alternate Tuesdays—whichever is the interpretation), that this interpretation be spelled out specifically in next collective agreement in conjunction with article 3.3.3, i.e., that faculty are expected to refrain from holding office hours, meeting with students or meeting with each other on Tuesday lunch hours (or during CFA meetings on alternate Tuesdays—whichever is the interpretation), so that faculty can guide themselves accordingly.
